

Glebe night improvement works

We're working in your area between Sunday 19 March and Friday 24 March.

What we're doing

Alstom Transport, maintenance contractor for Transdev Sydney (operators of the Inner West Light Rail), is undertaking ongoing civil maintenance works on the L1 Dulwich Hill Line at Glebe light rail stop.

The works will involve rail grinding of the track in both directions between Glebe tunnel and Darling Street underbridge.

How this affects you

Noise and light pollution

- Works will take place between 11:30pm and 5am, each night from Sunday 19 March to Friday 24 March.
- These works will create additional noise. You can expect to hear noise associated with rail hand tools. A switch grinding trolley will be operating along a 200 metre section along both tracks. You may also notice sparks from the grinding. Strict fire and safety controls will be in place along the rail corridor.
- Light pollution will be minimised by work parties directing lights away from properties.
- The NSW Environmental Protection Authority has been notified of these planned works.

Traffic and parking

- Work vehicles will access the rail corridor at Railway Street.
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside of this time.
